Sports review

A "sports review" ongoing.

- No more funding going into sport from the uni, so changes are going to happen to how clubs receive money, but not until next academic year. The only funding will come from Sports Lancaster(+) memberships. This shouldn't impact the Archery club massively.
- Additional sports hall is going to be built, within the next year or two, which will hopefully mean that there isn't as high demand for sports centre booking due to an extra hall.

Roses Performance 2019 & Roses Sport Development Funding

• Roses funding confirmed for next year (pays for Vlada coaching)

Roses performance:

- Lost all team events, won all individual events entered.
- Lack of attendance to Roses this year. No women attended.

Budgets

- Spending plans: James's coaching level 1, Vlada's coaching invoice.
 Haven't spent all of our funding due to unavailability of coach, so fewer coaching sessions.
- Need to agree with LUSU that we can fund James's level 1 coaching. Contact d.nash@lancaster.ac.uk to say that Sam asked to contact her regarding funding James's invoice.
- Rhys would like to do level 2 if price could be covered by LUSU.



Need to add more detail to the budget, total up expected price of Vlada's coaching and price of additional competitions, etc.

Training times, BUCS, Kit & Extra Competitions

- Would like 7-9am Thursday session back as a third session.
- Peak session 7-9pm Friday, Off peak 2-4pm Monday.

BUCS:

- Indoors: 3 total entries, 1 bronze medal.
- Outdoors: 2 entries, 1 silver medal and 1 bronze, both won by Rhys. Bad weather.

Ed Baker:

- Slow/no replies to emails making entry to competitions difficult, entries being done very last minute due to lack of communication from Ed.
- Abby will be returning, so communication should be through her in the future.
- Contact Sam if necessary as she can flag things up to Abby, she also offers to chase things up if communication is struggling.

NEUAL:

- Our regional competition that we attend.
- Would like more support for small tournaments like these in terms of transport.

Archery GB tournament held in local clubs – would like to attend these too to get qualifying scores for BUCS. Transport for these would also be good.



Sam: it appears that archery have not been allocated funding for extra competitions. There should be 50% contribution to these by the uni, which we should get in future if we budget for it.

- Request for shed near to outdoor range to enable easier setting up.
- Numbers in third term dropped. Sports centre would like to be informed if sessions aren't going to be running due to lack of attendance.
